Summit County Lincoln Day Committee

Summit County Lincoln Day Committee("JFC") is a joint fundraising committee composed of the Summit County Republican Party and Coughlin for Congress. (each, a "Committee," and, collectively, the "Committees"). Any contribution to the JFC permissible under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended ("FECA"), from contributors who have not exceeded their applicable Federal contribution limits, shall be allocated among the Committees pursuant to FECA and the formula set forth in this Notice.

Contributions Made by an Individual or Federal Non-Multicandidate Political Committee:

Individuals or federal non-multicandidate PACs may contribute up to \$11,600 annually. Such contributions shall be allocated in the following order:

- 1. The Summit County Republican Party shall receive an equal share of gross contributions raised through the committee with any individual contribution not exceeding \$5,000 per year.
- 2. Coughlin for Congress shall receive an equal share of gross contributions raised through the JFC with any individual contribution not to exceed \$3,300 for the primary election, and not to exceed \$3,300 for the general election.

Contributions Made by a Federal Multicandidate Political Committee:

Multicandidate PACs may contribute up to \$15,000 annually. Such contributions shall be allocated in the following order:

- 1. The Summit County Republican Party shall receive an equal share of all gross contributions raised through the committee with any any individual contribution not exceeding \$5,000 per year.
- 2. Coughlin for Congress shall receive an equal share of gross contributions raised through the JFC with any contribution not exceeding \$5,000 for the primary election, and not to exceed \$5,000 for the general election.

Contributions to the Summit County Lincoln Day Committee, or to any participating Committee individually, are not deductible as charitable donations for federal income tax purposes. Contributions from corporations, labor organizations, national banks, federal government contractors, foreign nationals without green cards, and other federally impermissible sources are prohibited. The contributor's signature designates his or her contribution to the elections described above. Contributions that exceed a donor's contribution limit to a participating Committee shall be reallocated to the remaining Committees according to this allocation formula to the extent permitted by FECA. Any contributor may designate his or her contribution to a specific participant Committee to the extent permitted by FECA. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in an election cycle or calendar year, as applicable.
